One table and two chairs are included with each indoor space. The club has reserved the hall.

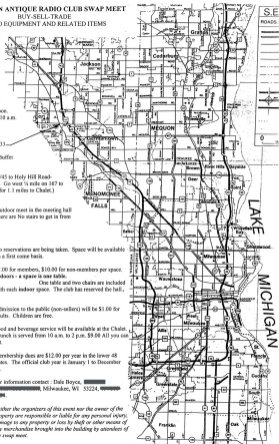
Admission: Admission to the public (non-sellers) will be \$1.00 for adults. Children are free.
