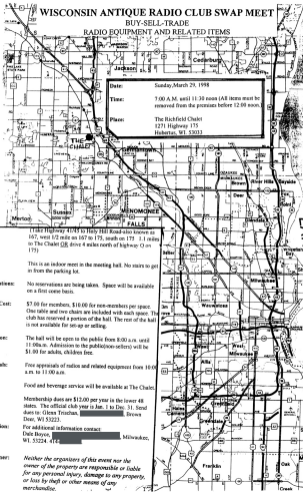
**Date:** Sunday, March 29, 1998
