Swap Meet Report for June 1, 1997

A lively swap meet was held in Milwaukee, Wisconsin on June 1, 1997.

We thank Bob and Cathy Evans for again hosting this meet in their parking lot as they did in October 1996.

Twenty sellers were registered. Sellers came from the following cities in Wisconsin: Appleton, Brookfield, Brown Deer, Green Lake, Hartland, Menomonee Falls, Milwaukee, New Berlin, Oregon, Palmyra, Racine, Waubesa and West Allis. Minnesotans came from Minneapolis and North St. Paul. Brookfield and Morton represented Illinois and folks came from Merrillville, IN.

Buyers came from Wisconsin as well as Chicago, Crystal Lake, Des Plaines and Gurnee, IL and Norwalk, OH. Many people driving by also stopped

to look and shop.

Items seen changing hands in the lot included: advertising items, a 1919 DeForest Panel unit, DeForest tube can, many brass based-tipped tubes, a variety of battery sets, horn and cone speakers, microphones, telegraph equipment, transistors, novelties such as a ship radio with chrome sails, other chrome front sets, cathedrals, tombstones, interesting plastic sets, commercial receivers, Zenith consoles, hi-fi equipment, parts and knobs, service manuals, new reference books, test equipment, etc.

A couple of nice Atwater Kent breadboards including a "Radiodyne" were on display.

Following the meet a few people accepted Bob Paquette's invitation to visit his internationally recognized Microphone Museum. His collection of over 800 microphones and related equipment is amazing! An indication of the quality and

depth of his Museum and archives is that the Smithsonian refers people with microphone questions to Bob. It seems that the Microphone collection at the Smithsonian is not as comprehensive as is Bob's. We are privileged to have this resource in Milwaukee.

Tentative meet dates for 1998 include the following Sundays: January 25, March 29, June 7 and October 4.

Since we have outgrown our present parking lot meet site, we are looking for a larger place with indoor space for winter meets.
